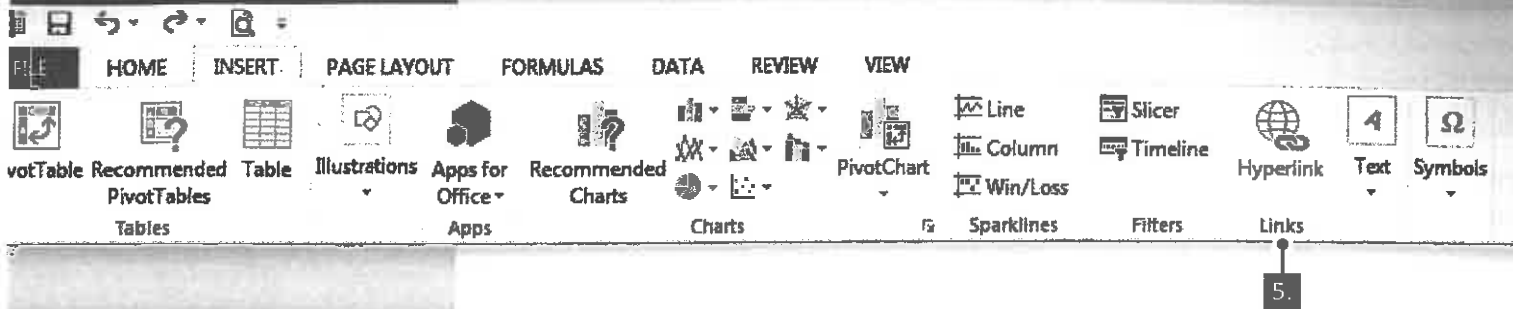
In this lesson, you will create a worksheet containing a list of colleges with information and a hyperlink for each college.

Review the following tools and terms that you will practice in this lesson, as you may be required to take a written assessment test after completing this unit.

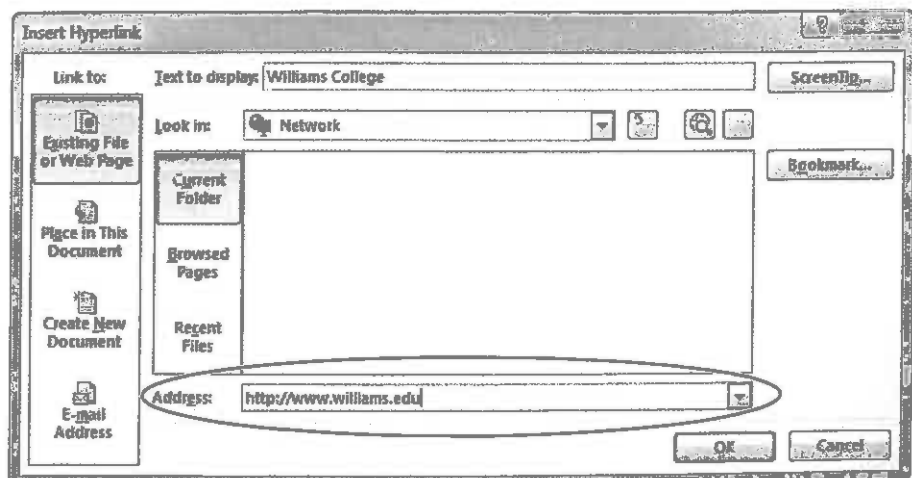

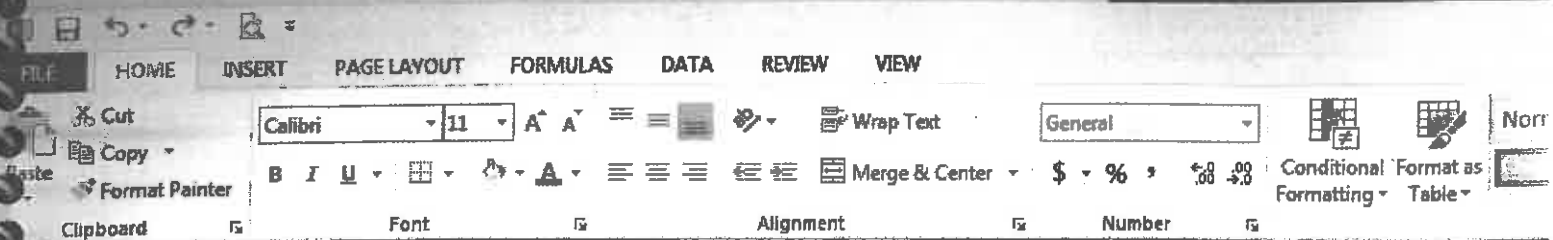

Instructions

1. Using Microsoft Excel 2013, create a new Blank workbook.
2. Save the file as *5.3 Top Liberal Arts Colleges* in your **My Excel Projects** folder.
 ☺ *Note: Unless otherwise noted, resize the column widths to fit cell contents.*
3. Key the data as shown in *5.3 Source Doc. A*.
4. Make the following formatting changes:
 - a. Change the orientation to Landscape
 - b. Insert a new blank row above row 2
 - c. Change the font size of cell A1 to 16
 - d. Italicize cell A1
 - e. Bold row 3
 - f. Right align cells A3, D3, and E3
 - g. Format column D for Accounting, 0 decimal places
 - h. Format column E for Comma with thousands separator, 0 decimal places
5. From the **INSERT** tab, **Links** group, do the following:
 - a. In cell B3, insert a **Hyperlink** to Williams College by keying the text [www.williams.edu] in the **Insert Hyperlink Address** box (as shown below)





- b. Continue adding hyperlinks to the list of colleges in column B, using the Website addresses in the table below

7. Sort by Tuition & Fees from smallest to largest.
8. Add the text [- Sorted by Tuition & Fees] to the title in A1.
9. Proofread your work for accuracy and format, then resave the file.
10. Select all cells containing data and Print Preview your worksheet.
11. Your worksheet should look similar to 5.3 *Source Doc. C*.
12. Print a copy if required.
